- Provided financial assistance to over 40% of the “Homes” residents who could not afford to pay for the quality institutional care that they needed (In 2017-2018 more than \$3,600,000 in funding for benevolent care was disbursed).
- Baptist Chaplains located at each of the “Homes” locations to aid in the continued spiritual journey of each resident.
- Provided a statewide system of resource counselors to answer questions related to the needs of aging persons...Baptist Elder Care Network.
